B. Bobcat's Cummer Concert Series Update

- Ms. Hauser gave an update on the interest of bands for the concert series.

C. Movies in the Park Update

- Ms. Hauser gave an update on movies in the park. We are good to go on the event but will be scaling back on free events in consideration of the financial health of the District.

D. Intergenerational Dinner

- Ms. Hauser reported that the event is gaining traction, and the participation numbers are growing, last dinner was at 60 people. Will get updated numbers for the next meeting.

E. Hesperia Days Rodeo Alcohol License Update

F. Hesperia Days and Hesperia Days Rodeo Tablets

1. Chair Member Blocker asked for tablets to be used for the events. A total of 8 tablets are requested. Ms. Garcia offered a suggestion that district phones are compatible with the Square payment device. Chairman Blocker liked the idea of utilizing district phones in addition to the tablets we have readily available for the event.

G. Upcoming Events Update:

1. Ms. Hauser reported on the opening of the pool at Lime Street Park this weekend and Kids Kamp starting in June. Next upcoming events are Movies in the Park, Bobcat Concert Series, Hesperia Days, Fall Festival and the Christmas Tree Lighting. Ms. Hauser cautioned about the new stop sign installation at Danbury and Arrowhead Lake Road potentially causing backups for upcoming events at the lake. General Manager Louie suggested a Traffic Control Company be contracted to manage the traffic on the day of the event. Chair Member Blocker liked the suggestion and will start looking for vendors.

2. Chair Member Blocker has been discussing a potential event at the Lake on the soccer fields. He suggests that the event will be virtually no cost to the District and will generate income from parking. He will make sure to check venue availability with Ms. Hauser before setting a date and time for the event.
