B. Park Ranger Report

- Chief Chavez gave an update on the ranger department. Contact numbers have increased due to the busier season. Fall sports are starting up and we have had lots of events over the past month. The Chief has been working on evaluating the security equipment and has started a list of equipment in need of replacement. Also, people have not been smoking on park property as usual, they are respecting the signs and asking for the smoking sections during events.

C. Maintenance Report

- Mr. Varner gave an update on the various work completed throughout the park properties. There was some painting done at the lake, including parking blocks, kiosks and the fisherman's restroom. Concrete was poured for the Tennis net at Lime Street Park, as well as a fence repair and glass door installation. TV's have been installed in the lobby and is now running advertisements. Tables have been ordered. The fountain feature has been cleaned and sanitized at the Hesperia Civic Plaza Park. Staff have been working to help deter the homeless from setting up encampments. The malibu playground was hit hard with Graffiti so the crew cleaned and sanitized the playground. Mr. Varner also inspected the LMD's and is making a list for the sub-contractor to take care of.

D. Update on Scoreboard Installations

- The scoreboard is ready to go and will be installed within the next few weeks.

E. P.O.S.T. Letter of Interest

- Lt. Richardson introduced the Police Officer Standards Training program for the ranger department. They would like to align the Ranger training program with P.O.S.T. guidance standards. A letter of interest needs to be sent so P.O.S.T. can initiate contact with us regarding program participation.

F. Update on the Power Play Center from the previous meeting

- The logo wrap has been installed. The new marquee is in place. The project is in the engineering phase.
